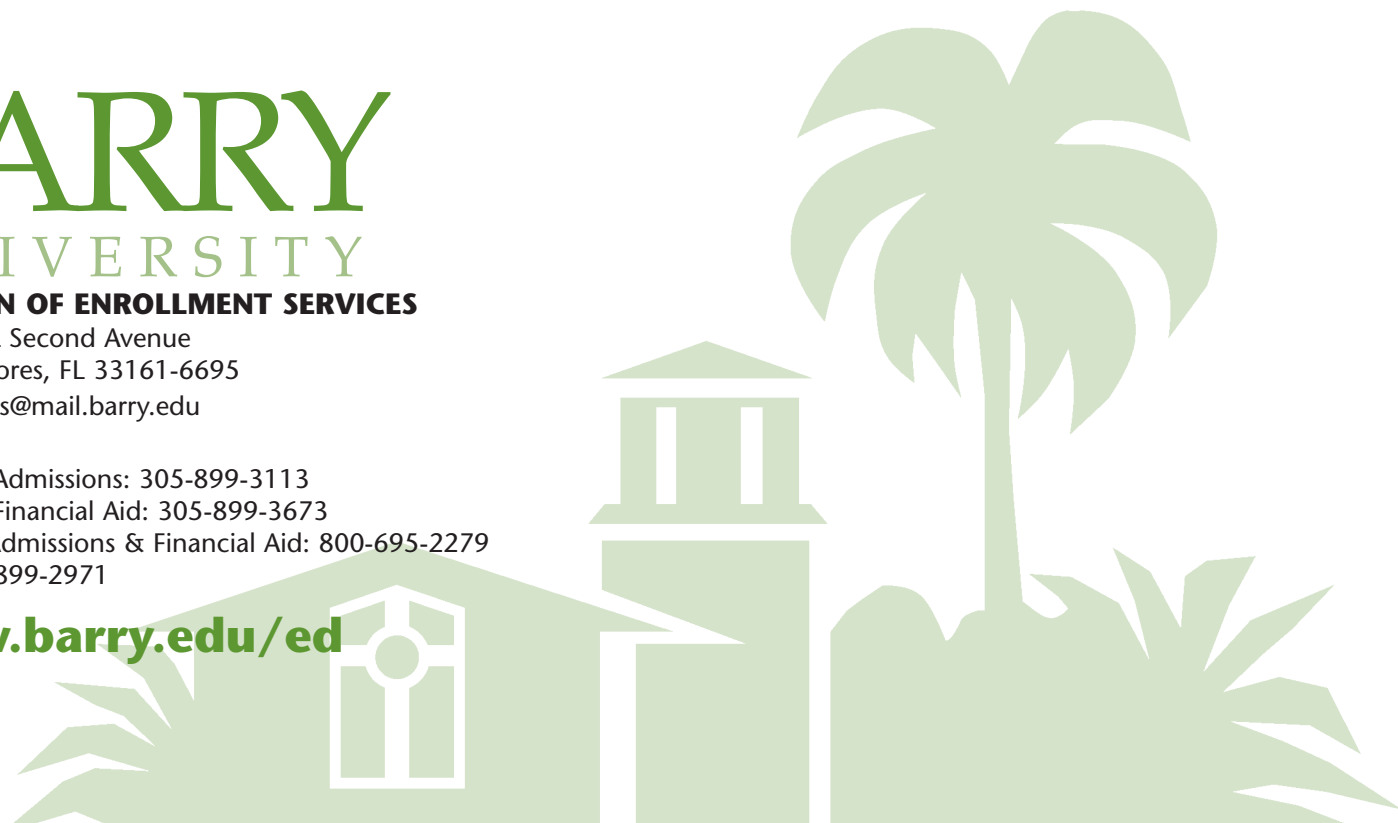

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Read the entire application carefully. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Please notify Barry University, Office of Admissions, immediately if there is a change of name, address, or phone number.

- 1. FEE** - A nonrefundable fee of \$30 must accompany this application. The fee is waived for Barry alumni. Checks are to be made payable to Barry University.
 - 2. APPLICATION DEADLINE** - Applications will be reviewed when submitted and complete. Early applications are welcome. The Doctoral Review Committee meets on the fourth Thursday of every month, except in the summer. Applications must be entirely complete at least one week before the committee meets in order to be reviewed at that month's meeting. Applications which do not meet this deadline will be held for the following month.
 - 3. TEST REQUIREMENTS** - All three sections of the GRE must be taken: verbal, quantitative, and writing. Test scores older than five years will not be considered. An international applicant who does not give evidence of being a native English speaker is required to take the TOEFL. Please arrange for an **official** score report to be sent to Barry University. [Institution code: 5053]
 - 4. TRANSCRIPT** - You must arrange to have an **official** transcript from ALL undergraduate and graduate schools attended sent to Barry University. Please request transcripts early. Barry University alumni need not request Barry University transcripts. Transcripts received from non-U.S. institutions must be translated and evaluated by a recognized agency. This is your responsibility. The translation/evaluation supplements the official document but does not replace it. Original official transcripts are required for admission.
 - 5. CAREER NARRATIVE STATEMENT** - Please answer the following questions on a separate sheet. Confine your answer to the specified word limit.
 - A. What is important to you and why? What do you consider to be the most important contribution you have made to your organization/company/school/community in the past five years? What are your current volunteer interests? What are your current professional activities? (300 words)
 - B. What are your professional goals in the next ten years? How will this doctoral degree help you meet these goals? (150 words)
 - C. (Not required for the Ph.D. in Counseling) What does leadership mean to you (in your chosen area of specialization, if applicable) and why are you seeking admittance to this particular doctoral program? (300 words)
 - 6. RECOMMENDATIONS** - Three recommendations are required - one from your employer; one from a professor who taught you at the master's/specialist degree level; and one from a professional contact. It is your responsibility to request these from those individuals previously noted. These recommendations become a part your permanent file. All recommendations should be sent by the recommending person to Barry University. Recommendations you submit directly will not be accepted. Recommendation forms and envelopes are included in the application packet for this purpose.
 - 7. INTERVIEW** - Based upon the application and recommendations, you may be scheduled for an interview and required to complete a writing sample as part of the admission process.
 - 8. NOTIFICATION** - You will be advised in writing of the decision regarding the status of your acceptance into the School of Education's doctoral program.
