

## Application for Non-degree Admission Undergraduate or Graduate

Non-degree students are welcome to apply to Barry University for personal and/or professional enrichment or for purposes of teacher certification. There is a limit to the number of credits earned through non-degree studies. If in the future you wish to seek a degree, you will need to complete a degree application, which can be requested from the Admissions Office. Enrollment as a non-degree student in no way implies full admission to a degree program. Non-degree applicants are not eligible for financial aid or Barry's Tuition Assistance Plan.
