DESCRIPTION

Tuesday Night Lights Hitting Camp provides the player an opportunity to tune up their hitting skills before starting up with their high school baseball season. Attendees have a unique opportunity to not only demonstrate their hitting skills in front of the Barry University Baseball Staff, but also get special one on one instruction from the coaches as well as hitting on one of NCAA's prestigious baseball fields and batting cages.



“2009 WAS THE BEST HITTING PERFORMANCE IN SCHOOL HISTORY”

Barry broke several records this year including home runs as a team (105), runs (551), RBI (506), walks (312) and wins (44). The Bucs were also on pace to break team school records in batting average (.348), slugging percentage (.594), on base percentage (.444), hits allowed (460), runs allowed (232), walks (138) and ERA (3.79). Barry broke the NCAA Division II record for grand slams in a season with ten.

Individually, Yudelmis Hernandez broke the school mark for home runs at 22, while also breaking the extra base hit record at 39.

Yan Gomes broke the RBI mark at 92 and he also broke the total bases record at 172, while also being tied for the school record in sacrifice flies with eight.

Danny Lima broke the school record for hits at 91 while Yas Gutierrez broke the school record for runs at 72.
