## Program Accomplishments

### 2008 – 2009

Based on the mission of all partnership schools, the topic of **"Creating an Inclusive Community through Understanding Our Differences and Celebrating Our Diversity"** was the 2008-2009 inaugural year theme. Four Community Conversations were hosted by Miami Country Day School, Doctors Charter School, The Cushman School, and Barry University. These conversations were followed by two keynote presentations on celebrating diversity by Coach Boone and Coach Yoast, who were featured in Disney's "Remember the Titans." More than 1500 CLP students, parents, faculty, teachers, and community members were in attendance.

### 2009-2010

Given the growing national and local emphasis on fostering community and citizenship, the theme of **"Fostering Citizenship in a Global World"** was chosen in 2009-2010. The CLP offered four Community Conversations geared toward character building activities, civic literacy, community engagement, and service. Community Conversations, hosted by Barry University, The Cushman School, Miami Country Day School, and Archbishop Curley Notre Dame High School, featured presentations on what it means to be a citizen, discussions on global citizenship and world religions, and a "Mock City Council" with real members of local municipalities. Highlights of the year included keynote speaker Senator Bob Graham, who spoke with over 650 students, teachers, faculty, administrators and community members at Barry University. The Haiti relief efforts of all CLP Schools were featured at Miami Shores' Annual Unity Day and Archbishop Curley's Community Conversation.

### 2010-2011

Given the positive response to the theme of citizenship, this year's theme will further discussions on "Becoming an Engaged Citizen." Activities and events planned include: a "Community Reader" to further explore this topic, Barry University's Fall Conference entitled "Soulful Citizenship: Pursuing Social Justice through Collaborative Partnerships," Community Conversations and keynote speakers. New this year, a Teacher Professional Development Conference titled, At the Heart of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learning, will be held on February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at Barry University featuring Keynote Speaker Daniel Pink, author of *A Whole New Mind* and *Drive*.
