Miller Analogies Test

WHAT IS THE MILLER ANALOGIES TEST?

The Miller Analogies Test (MAT) has been used as a graduate school admission test for more than 70 years in university programs throughout the United States. The MAT is a high-level mental ability test that evaluates your ability to solve analytical problems stated in the form of analogies.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO TAKE THE TEST?

The fee for taking the test is \$80 payable by only cash or money order. The Center for Counseling and Psychological Services must receive payment at least one week prior to the test date in order to reserve your seat. The fee is nonrefundable and nontransferable. No checks or credit cards will be accepted. Make money orders payable to Barry University. Include your name, address, and phone number on the money order. You will be given a receipt.

HOW DO I RESERVE A SEAT?

Once you select a test date, you may reserve your seat by paying the test fee in person or by mailing your payment with the attached reservation form. You must make your reservation at least one week prior to your preferred test date. The test may be cancelled if no one else signs up for the same date.

Note: Because there are only 20 seats available for each test date, you cannot reserve a seat without payment or reschedule your test date after making a reservation. If you do not take the test on the date that you selected, you will not receive a refund. You will have to re-apply and pay again.

This is strictly enforced. Please make sure that you will be able to take the test on the date that you select.

RE-TESTS

When reserving your seat, you must inform the Counseling Center if you have previously taken the MAT. If you take the same test form twice in one year, The Psychological Corporation will void your test. For this reason, you must have the re-test admission ticket that was sent to you attached to the scores of the previous test. Give this ticket to the proctor on your scheduled test date so that you will be given the appropriate test form. If you do not give the proctor your ticket, you run the risk of having your test invalidated. You can obtain a duplicate of the re-test admission ticket by calling The Psychological Corporation at 800-622-3231.

INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES

If you have a disability requiring special accommodations, you must notify the Counseling Center 14 days prior to the test date. You will be required to provide documentation of the disability.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

1. Two identification cards, including one picture ID (such as a driver's license)
2. Sharpened No. 2 pencils
3. Your re-test ticket if you have taken the test in the previous year
4. Addresses of schools where you want the results sent
5. Your Social Security number or passport

Note: No books or papers are permitted in the testing room.

RESULTS

Results will be sent to you and to the schools you request approximately 20 days after the test date. The Counseling Center does not receive your results. Test scores are valid for five years from the test date.

HOW CAN I PREPARE FOR THE MAT?

You can familiarize yourself with the test format and with different types of analogies by reading the Miller Analogies Test study guide, available in most major bookstores.
