

The Florida Resident Access Grant (FRAG) provides tuition assistance to students attending nonprofit private colleges/universities in the state of Florida. To be eligible to receive this grant, a student must meet Florida's residency requirements for receipt of state student financial aid; students must meet both requirements below:

- Have lived in Florida for a minimum of 12 consecutive months prior to the first day of class
- Demonstrate that you are living in Florida for reasons other than education

If you have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and listed a state other than Florida as your state of legal residency, we need proof that you are a Florida resident in order for you to be eligible for the FRAG. All documentation must be submitted within 30 days of Barry's denial notice and sent directly to the Financial Aid Office.

Please submit copies of three out of the following eight documents:

- Voter registration (state, issue date)
- Driver's license
- Vehicle registration for current and last year
- Federal income tax return from previous year
- Pay stub demonstrating 12 months of employment
- Home mortgage
- Rent receipts for past year
- Employment documents (employment verification letter)

Note: Documents must have been issued at least one year prior to the first day of classes to prove that you were a resident for a full year.

Documentation not proving 12 months of Florida residency prior to the school start date will significantly delay the financial aid process.
