## John Graves Thompson Award for Outstanding Freshman

The John Graves Thompson Award is presented to a **freshman** in honor of one of the University's founders. This award is given for outstanding service and leadership by a Barry University freshmen.

# Eligibility

- 1. Student must have 0-29 completed credits at the end of fall 2021
- 2. Student must have earned a **cumulative** grade point average of at least 3.0 at Barry at the time of nomination
- 3. Student must not have been found responsible of any major infractions of acceptable behavior, as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct

## Criteria for Evaluation

- 1. Student has established exceptional initiative in service
- 2. Student has demonstrated outstanding leadership skills
- 3. Quality and impact of his/her contributions to the Barry Community

# Mother Gerald Barry Award for Outstanding Sophomore

The Mother Gerald Barry Award is presented to a **sophomore** in honor of one of the University's founders. The award is given for outstanding service and leadership, and for establishing an excellent record for progressive academic achievement while at Barry.

## **Eligibility**

- 1. Student must have 30 59 completed credits at the end of fall 2021
- 2. Student must have earned a **cumulative** grade point average of at least 3.0 at Barry at the time of nomination
- 3. Student must not have been found responsible of any major infractions of

acceptable behavior, as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct

## Criteria for Evaluation

- 1. Student has established exceptional initiative in service
- 2. Student has demonstrated outstanding leadership skills
- 3. Quality and impact of his/her contributions to the Barry Community

## Dr. George J. Wanko Award for Outstanding Junior

This award is presented to a **junior** in honor of Dr. George Wanko, Vice President for Student Services from 1978 to 1999. The award is given for outstanding service and leadership, and for establishing an excellent record for progressive academic achievement while at Barry University by maintaining a grade point average of at least 3.0.

# **Eligibility**

- 1. Student must have 60 89 completed credits at the end of fall 2021
- 2. Student must have earned a **cumulative** grade point average of at least 3.0 at Barry at the time of nomination
- 3. Student must not have been found responsible of any major infractions of acceptable behavior, as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct

## Criteria for Evaluation

- 1. Student has established exceptional initiative in service
- 2. Student has demonstrated outstanding leadership skills
- 3. Quality and impact of his/her contributions to the Barry Community

Application Process: Students who are nominated for the Freshmen,
Sophomore and Junior Class Awards will be notified after the Dean of
Students checks eligibility based on grades and conduct.

Students must complete and submit:

#### Cover letter

Highlight the student's commitment to service and leadership in cocurricular campus involvement and how his/her service has impacted the Barry Community

• Student's most recent resume

# President's Award for Outstanding Senior

The President's Award is the most prestigious annual student award presented by the Barry University President to an outstanding graduating **senior**.

## Eligibility

A nominee must meet **all** of the following criteria:

- Student must be a graduating senior who has been enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student at Barry for not less than three (3) years or who have taken at least 90 credits at Barry;
- Student must have successfully completed all degree requirements for May graduation; (Graduating seniors may be nominated if they have one course to complete in Summer Session I.)
- Student must have earned a cumulative grade point average of at least
   3.5 at Barry at the time of nomination;
- Student must not have outstanding financial obligations to the University;
- Student must not have found responsible of any major infractions of acceptable behavior, as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct;

# Criteria for Evaluation

 Student must have demonstrated outstanding service, exemplary leadership qualities, personal initiative, and creativity while a Barry student in a variety of approved institutional organizations or activities that benefit the Barry community and other communities or organizations that we serve in keeping with our Mission and Core Commitments.

Application Deadline: April 12, 2021 5:00 pm

**Application Process**: Students who have been nominated for The President's Award will be notified after the Dean of Students checks eligibility based on grades and conduct.

Students must complete and submit:

- Cover letter
  - Highlight the student's commitment to service and leadership in cocurricular campus involvement and how his/her service has impacted the Barry Community
- Student's most recent resume
- One recommendation letter
   From Barry University faculty or staff member
