Important URLs: Use <http://access.barry.edu> ; <http://ezproxy.barry.edu> for remote access to resources. Use <http://webmail.barry.edu>, for e-mail, first time users, log-in or to e-mail IT. Call **305 899-3604** and press 4 for additional technical support questions.

Catalogs: Compare the uses of **BLISSWeb** and **World Cat**

Try some of these terms or subject headings for searching: “women and business”; “gender and success”; “gender and stereotypes”. Do a keyword search for these series: **Opposing Viewpoints**; **Reference Shelf**; **Current Controversies**.

Call Numbers: Library of Congress call numbers are a combination of letters and numbers used to provide a “shelf address” for each book. The letter **P**, for example, is used for Language and Literature. Locate: *CQ Researcher* REF H35.C67; *Facts on File* REF D410.F3; *Encyclopedia of Human Behavior* REF BF31.E5;

Databases: Databases are indexes of articles about various topics. Most focus on a particular subject area. Search **Electronic Databases** by **Subject** or by **Title** (for example: Miami Herald)
