Continuing education outcomes are based on enrollment data for the Fall semester of 2019 and preliminary Winter/Spring semester of 2020.

Employment outcomes are based on the 4th qtr (October to December) of 2019.

Full-time is defined as earning at least minimum wage for 13 weeks (\$4,399).

Students may be in multiple programs, therefore the details may exceed the total unduplicated count.

Values are displayed when 10 or more students are counted.

Values less than 10, but greater than 0, are suppressed with (****) for numeric values and (***%) for percent values.

Values equal to 0 are suppressed with (-) for numeric values.

Percent values are suppressed when the numerator is less than 10 and the denominator is 10 or more.
