## HONORS CERTIFICATE IN LITIGATION AND ADVOCACY

1. The purpose is to create a Certificate-type program emphasizing litigation skills.
2. To obtain the certificate:
  - a. Required – a student must complete all of (1), (2) and (3) (number following course is number of credit hours):
    1. Motions and Depositions (3)
    2. Any law school Trial Advocacy course (3); or, receiving credit as an advocate (not a witness) in a Trial Team extramural competition (1).
    3. A clinical experience in a litigation placement – one of the following:
      - a. Civil Poverty Externship (5)
      - b. Criminal Defense Externship (6)
      - c. Environmental & Earth Advocacy Clinic (6)
      - d. Immigration Clinic (6)
      - e. Juvenile Defense Clinic (6)
      - f. Prosecution Externship (6)
  - b. Additionally, a student must take **two additional courses** from any combination of the following:
    - a. Advanced Appellate Advocacy (3) **OR** Moot Court (Advocate) (1) **(not both)**
    - b. Advanced Criminal Procedure (3)
    - c. Advanced Legal Writing (3)
    - d. Civil Poverty Externship (5)
    - e. Criminal Defense Externship (6)
    - f. Environmental & Earth Advocacy Clinic (6)
    - g. FL Criminal Procedure (2)
    - h. Florida Evidence (3)
    - i. Immigration Clinic (6)
    - j. Juvenile Defense Clinic (6)
    - k. Judicial Externship (2)
    - l. Mediation (3) **OR** Mediation Externship (2) **(not both)**
    - m. Prosecution Externship (6)
    - n. Trial Team -- second extramural competition as an advocate (not a witness) (1).
3. A student must achieve a minimum overall GPA of 2.800 in the graded courses above to receive this Certificate, **including** at least seven hours of graded (non P/F) credits.
4. A student will receive the designation of “High Honors” if s/he achieves a minimum over all GPA of 3.750 in the graded (non P/F) courses above.
