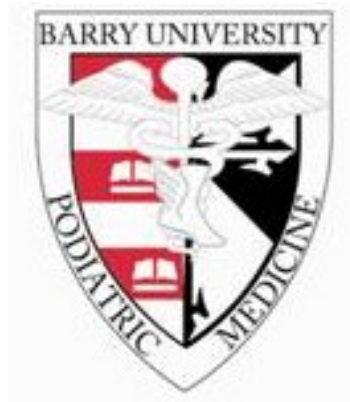

##### **From the South:**

I-95 North to NW 119th Street - Exit 9 (old exit 12). Turn right (east) at the light onto NW 119th Street. Turn right (south) onto NW 2nd Avenue. Main entrance and visitor parking are on the right (west) side of NW 2nd Avenue between NW 115th Street and NW 112th Terrace.

**Program Objectives**

At the conclusion of each session the physician should be able to:

**Thursday, September 10, 2009\***

1. Identify the appropriate application for bioengineered alternative tissues
2. Properly clinically assess the chronic wound environment
3. Identify the risk factors for limb loss.

**Thursday, October 8, 2009\***

1. Diagnose and manage exercise induced leg pain including compartment syndrome and shin splints.
2. Diagnose and manage injuries commonly seen in runners including subungual exostosis and plantar fasciitis.
3. Correctly evaluate and prescribe athletic shoes.
4. Be proficient in the physical examination of the knee, foot, and ankle.

**Saturday, October 24, 2009\***

1. Define appropriate protocols and procedures applicable to HIV counseling, testing and reporting as defined by the Florida State Legislature.
2. Recognize and apply proper charting and other techniques to minimize risk in practice.
3. Understand and demonstrate compliance with the current Florida laws and rules.
4. Understand the new Florida requirement covering medical errors.

**Thursday, November 12, 2009\***

1. Present current developments and treatments in tropical medicine.
2. Educate, identify, diagnose and treat venomous bites, stings and marine toxins.

**Thursday, December 10, 2009\***

1. Identify the strengths of Musculoskeletal Ultrasound over MRI.
2. Identify the equipment specifications necessary for Musculoskeletal Ultrasound of the lower extremity.
