Sean D. Foreman is an Assistant Professor of Political Science at Barry University and holds a M.A. in International Studies from Florida International University and a B.A. in Political Science with a minor in History from Clarion University of Pennsylvania.

Dr. Foreman regularly extends his expertise outside the classroom, reaching the community through various media outlets. He is a regular panelist on WPBT-TV’s *“Issues”* and an occasional guest on Comcast’s *“Newsmakers,”* Local 10 News and CBS-4 news shows. Dr. Foreman is the Political Expert and does monthly radio interviews for K107 in Wisconsin. He is also a frequent guest on WFTL 850 AM NewsTalk radio out of Ft. Lauderdale and is sometimes interviewed by WLRN and WIOD in South Florida.

Dr. Foreman’s current research interests include U.S. elections, state and local government and politics, and the politics and economics of sports in America. He is the author of a chapter on the Districts 21 and 25 Congressional elections for the forthcoming book *Roads to Congress 2008*.
