



POST-GRADUATE RESIDENCY PROGRAM FOR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS IN EMERGENCY MEDICINE

University of Missouri Health Care, Women's and Children's Hospital and the University of Missouri School of Medicine are offering an intense and rewarding post-graduate residency for physician assistants in emergency medicine.

MU Health Care boasts over 400 hospital beds in central Missouri. It serves as central Missouri's only Level I trauma center and as a tertiary referral center for much of mid-Missouri.

As part of an academic medical center, MU Health Care is host to many physician residencies, fellowship programs and other physician assistant residencies.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Physician assistants in the emergency residency program will work with and under the supervision of emergency medicine, internal medicine, surgical and critical care physician assistants and physicians.

The duration of the program is 12 months. During that time you will:

- Rotate through the hospital Emergency Departments, adult and pediatric medical or surgical intensive care units and medicine wards. Other medical and surgical subspecialties will be used to augment the residents' training.
- Be trained to monitor, diagnose and treat critically ill/injured patients'.
- Receive hands-on experience in preparation for performing supervised bedside interventions.
- Receive procedural training within rotations.
- Be expected to attend and participate in grand rounds, journal club, departmental lectures, conferences and lectures by guest speakers.

The experience will prepare residents for successful careers as physician assistants in emergency medicine. After graduating from the program, residents will receive a certificate of completion from the University of Missouri as a physician assistant in emergency medicine. This unique residency provides a foundation experience for PA's preparing for the specialty examination in emergency medicine by the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants (NCCPA).

PAY AND BENEFITS

Physician assistant residents will receive an annual salary of \$50,000-\$55,000 as well as University of Missouri employee benefits, including medical insurance, paid vacation and sick time off. Continuing medical education funds will be available.

REQUIREMENTS:

Physician assistants must be NCCPA-certified or eligible and must be able to obtain a Missouri physician assistant license and University of Missouri hospital privileges. To apply, you must complete an application and include the \$45 application fee. A personal interview will be required. Program admission is limited to two physician assistants each July.

Program duration is 12 months.***
