For Sophomores:


- After completing an application, your pre-nursing advisor will guide you through the process and make sure you have all the necessary pre-requisite courses.
- Once you complete your pre-requisite courses and are accepted into the BSN program, a representative from the program will email/ mail you a copy of the Baptist BOND application
- Once your application is submitted, a representative from the Baptist Scholars department will setup an interview
- After the interview is completed, you will be notified of your acceptance.
