
Bachelor of Science in Education

Specialization Options: Early Childhood, Elementary, Exceptional Student Education

This Bachelor of Science in Education, offered by <u>Barry University</u>, provides job-embedded coursework for candidates working in schools. Candidates who have an associate's degree or equivalent general education coursework can enroll in this on-the-job degree completion program. The program includes 60 credit hours of coursework. Most candidates complete this program in two years.

Upon successful completion of the program, candidates specializing in Infancy Through Early Childhood Education are eligible for certification in Prekindergarten/Primary Education. Those specializing in Early and Middle Childhood Education (K-6) are eligible for certification in Elementary Education, and candidates specializing in Special Education are eligible for a certification in Exceptional Student Education (PK-12).

Candidates may begin this program in the fall or spring semesters, pending available seats.
