Graduates represent the population with valid Social Security numbers.

Employment outcomes are based on Q4 2020 (October to December) employment and wage data.

Q4 2020 earnings are multiplied by four to estimate annual earnings.

Students may be in multiple programs, therefore the details may exceed the total unduplicated count.
