

BarryACCESS Program

BarryACCESS is designed to make obtaining required digital course materials simple, convenient, and affordable. Students enrolled in participating courses receive access to their digital textbooks, courseware, and other learning resources on the first day of class.

Materials are available directly through the **BibliU Library** tab in Canvas, eliminating the need to shop for books separately or wait for delivery. The cost is placed on the student's account as a **Course Book Fee (CBF)**.

How It Works

Students enrolled in a participating course are automatically provided access to the required digital materials when the course begins. Course-by-course pricing is available in a downloadable PDF on the mybarrystore.com.

If none of a student's courses participate in BarryACCESS, the student will not receive a BarryACCESS charge.

To access BarryACCESS materials:

1. Log in to Barry Canvas.
2. Open the participating course.
3. Select the **BibliU Library** tab.
4. Open the available digital textbook or courseware.

Students may also access their materials on another device by downloading the **BibliU app**. Depending on the title, available features may include read-aloud options, highlighting, note-taking, and offline access. Work completed offline will sync after the device reconnects to the internet. Opt-Out Option

Participation in BarryACCESS is optional. Students who prefer to obtain their materials independently may opt out through the **BibliU Library** tab in Canvas before the applicable deadline.

Students who opt out will lose access to the digital materials provided through BarryACCESS. The corresponding Course Book Fee will be credited to their student account within 48 hours.

Students who do not opt out by the deadline will remain responsible for the charge, even if they do not use the materials or later withdraw from the course. The applicable deadline is also displayed within the BibliU Library in Canvas.

Important Information

- Digital materials become unavailable after a student opts out.
- Students may opt back in before the applicable opt-out deadline.

- Opt-outs and refunds cannot be processed after the deadline.
- Law School programs are exempt from BarryACCESS.
- Students whose courses do not participate will not receive BarryACCESS charges.
