CALL FOR PROPOSALS

Submission deadline: Friday, January 28

Barry University's Center for Community Service Initiatives (CCSI) invites students, faculty, staff, and community partners to submit proposals for presentations at the Eighth Annual Community Engagement Symposium. The Symposium will be held on Wednesday, March 30, 2022.

Proposals should address the theme of the Symposium, "Effectively Balancing Community Impact with Student Learning Outcomes."

Presentation Title:	The title of the proposed presentation must be included in the submission.
Presentation Format:	The presentation must be either audiovisual or in a poster format.
Student Learning Outcomes:	Student learning outcomes of the course, program, or project must be listed.
Community Impact:	The community impact of the course, program, or project must be described in 76 words or fewer.
Participant Engagement:	A brief (maximum 40-word) statement of how the presentation will engage attendees must be included.
Community Engagement/Experiential Learning Practice:	The specific community engagement or experiential learning practice – service-learning, community-based research, study abroad, internship, capstone/practicum, fieldwork/student teaching/clinical placement, co-curricular project, other – must be identified.
Abstract:	An abstract of approximately 80 words must be included in the proposal.
Submission Deadline:	Proposals for 50-minute presentations should be submitted by January 28. All proposals will be evaluated by peer reviewers.
