When Zhasmina Kerimova '25 arrived at Barry University from Turkmenistan, she carried ambition, determination, and the hopes of her family. As an international and first-generation college student, an American education once felt out of reach.

That changed with the Stamps Scholarship and SMIF Award. With full financial support, financial barriers were removed, allowing Zhasmina to fully embrace the Barry experience. *"I did not have to constantly worry about finances," she shares. "Instead, I focused on academics, leadership, internships, and giving back."*

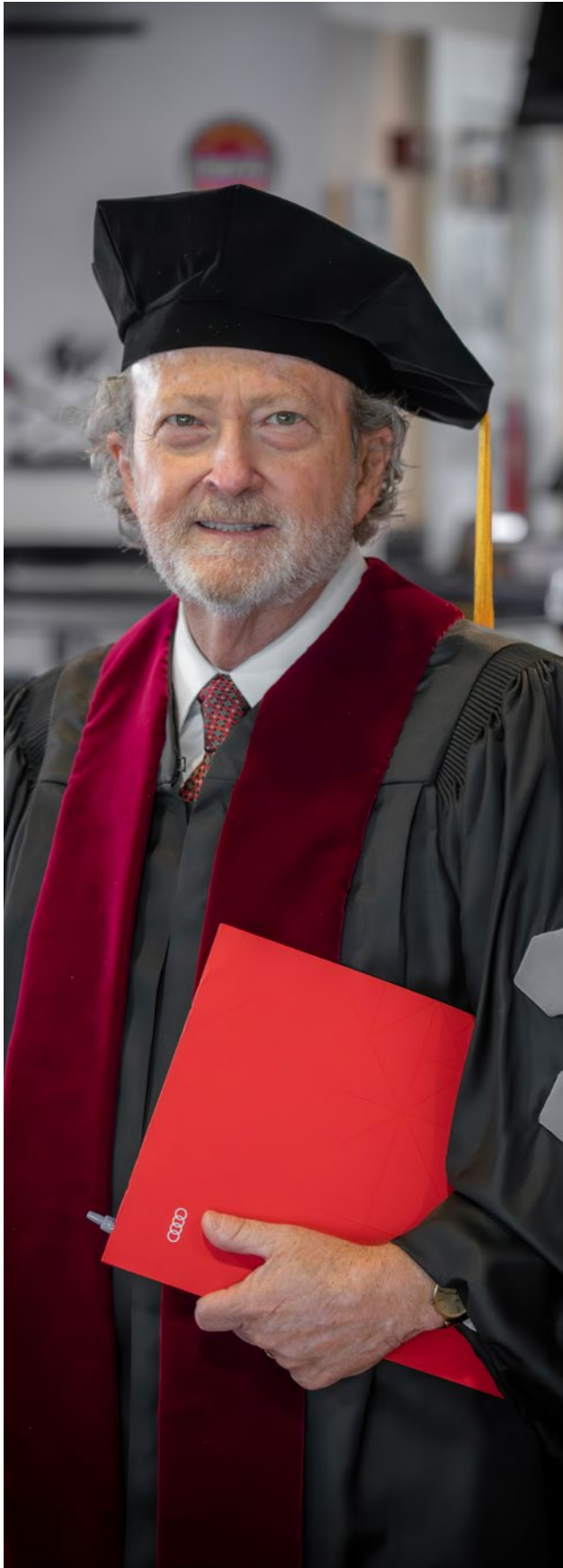
From her first year, she became a Student Ambassador, welcoming prospective students and families. She later served as Co-Managing Director of the Student Managed Investment Fund (SMIF), mentoring peers and leading real world investment strategy.

Through this experience, she earned a competitive internship with Morgan Stanley in New York City, gaining hands on experience in wealth management and portfolio construction. *"Scholarship support gave me the confidence to aim higher," she says.*

Now completing her MBA, Zhasmina has passed the Securities Industry Essentials exam and recently sat for CFA Level I. She plans to build a career in wealth management and earn her CFA charter.

Santander Bank Invests in AI Education and Last Mile Scholarships

Santander Bank has committed a \$500,000 investment over two years to support the Barry University AI Center and the Last Mile Scholarship. This partnership advances two priorities that shape the university's future: preparing students to succeed in an economy increasingly influenced by artificial intelligence and ensuring that students who are close to graduation can complete their degrees.

Support for the Barry University AI Center expands the university's capacity to integrate artificial intelligence across academic programs. AI concepts and tools are being incorporated into coursework across disciplines, including business, health sciences, education, law, and the liberal arts. As these integrations continue, the impact will extend across Barry University's campus community of approximately 6,800 students. Students will graduate with exposure to emerging technologies, a practical understanding of AI applications, and skills aligned with evolving workforce demands.

The investment also supports the Last Mile Scholarship, which assists students facing financial barriers during the final stage of their academic journey. As students near graduation, many face small but impactful financial gaps

that can interrupt or prevent their ability to finish their degrees. Last Mile Scholarships provide targeted support during a student's final semester, allowing them to remain enrolled and graduate on time. Access to this assistance reduces financial stress and ensures that years of academic progress lead to a completed degree.

Combined support for the AI Center and Last Mile Scholarships expands opportunity and improves outcome for Barry University students. AI integration enhances the educational experience across the institution, while Last Mile Scholarships help students nearing graduation cross the finish line and begin their professional careers.

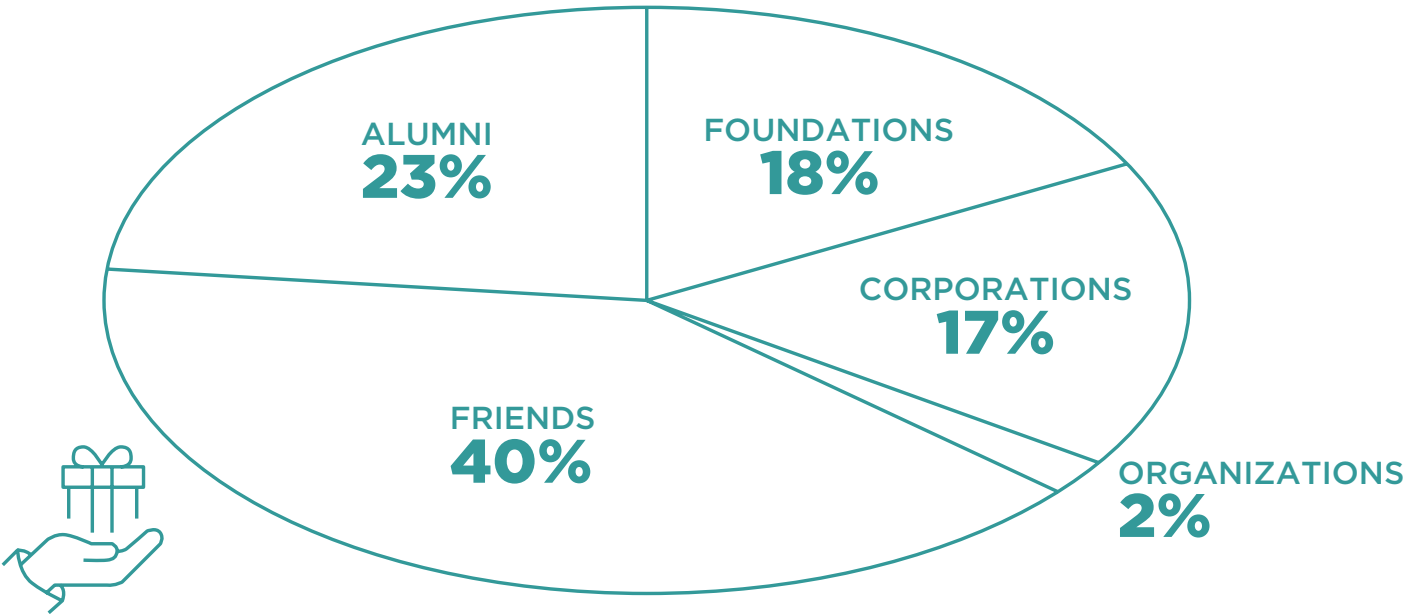

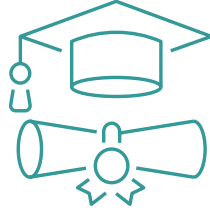

SHOWING UP WITH HEART

How The Honorable Dr. Billy Joel, L.H.D. (h.c.) '25 Inspired Future Barry Leaders



During Barry University's 2025 Doctoral Commencement Ceremony, The Honorable Dr. Billy Joel, L.H.D. (h.c.) '25 delivered a message that deeply resonated with the Doctoral Class of 2025. He invited graduates to pause and fully absorb the weight of their accomplishment.

"You. Did. It."

In a room filled with celebration, Dr. Joel shifted the focus away from accolades and toward responsibility. He reminded graduates that their degrees were not merely titles to carry, but tools to use in service of others. Rooted in Barry's values, his words challenged each scholar to consider how their expertise would shape the lives of those around them.

"Wherever life takes you, show up with heart," he urged. "Show up for the people who need your voice. Show up for the issues that demand your expertise. Show up for yourself with confidence, integrity, and compassion."

His message centered on the idea that true success is measured not only by achievement, but by impact. It is defined by how one leads, how one serves, and how one chooses to live with purpose.

That message did not end when the ceremony concluded.

Following commencement, Dr. Joel and his wife, Sandra, strengthened their commitment to Barry students through

the establishment of The Honorable Dr. Billy Joel & Sandra Joel Scholarship Endowment. What began as a call to responsibility became a tangible investment in opportunity. The endowment reflects the couple's enduring belief that education is the foundation of community well-being and that for many students, a college degree represents hope not only for themselves, but for their families.

Already, that investment is making a difference. This year, the scholarship was awarded to Courtney Michel, marking this the first direct impact of the fund. For students like Courtney, this support represents more than financial assistance.

It is encouragement, affirmation, and access. It serves as a reminder that someone believes in their potential and is willing to stand behind it.
